Summary: DEL improved the reporting form, resulting in a better way to track incidents and injuries in child care facilities.

Details:

<u>Description of the problem</u>: The form the child care providers are required to use for reporting information on child care injuries/incidents is out of date, not always user friendly, and leads to inconsistent reporting. Additionally, the information was not being collected and used in a way that helped the agency better understand the injuries/incidents and implement policy changes to improve child safety.

<u>Description of the improvement</u>: DEL improved the reporting form resulting in a better way to track incidents and injuries in child care facilities. We are moving towards providing access to an electronic version that we hope to have available in early 2016.

<u>Specific results achieved</u>: DEL has implemented a new process that will allow us to collect and summary statistics on injuries/incidents, that can be used to make and implement more informed policy improve child safety.

How we involved customers or stakeholders in this effort: One director of a local child care center participated in our Value Stream Process Mapping on May 15, 2014. A total of 10 facilities participated in the 60-day pilot of the new form, with around 62 forms returned to us. Nine of those followed up by taking a Survey Monkey survey. Ten returned at the end of the pilot period and gave additional suggestions and ways to improve the form.

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
